Due to COVID-19 it is very difficult to communicate with parents.

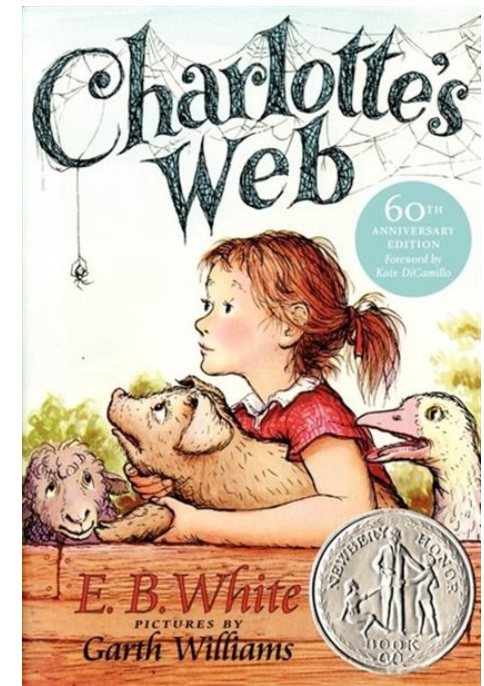

English:

As the children have missed a lot of the curriculum we are focusing on basic skills. We will be revisiting sentence structure, punctuation, spelling patterns and rules, reading skills and grammar.

We will also be learning to write poetry. We will be looking at the features of acrostic poems and rhyming poems and writing our own.

We will also be assessing the children's reading and writing which will help to inform future planning.
